Conditions of Permit:

1. ALL OPEN BURNING MUST HAVE A PERMIT.
2. This permit is good from 8 am to 3 pm, on the specified dates and no combustible materials may be added to the burn between 3 pm and 8 am. Once the burn has begun, the permit holder is responsible for monitoring atmospheric conditions that may have an adverse effect on public enjoyment or health.
3. Only vegetation and clean wood may be burned. Materials that are unlawful to burn include but are not limited to rubber products, plastics, paper, cardboard, asphalt, petroleum products, treated or painted wood, wallboard, chemicals, garbage and refuse
4. One single pile may be burned at a time measuring approximately 6x6x3 (LxWxH).
5. The fire must be constantly attended by a competent person with a means of extinguishment, preferably a water hose.
6. No flammable liquids shall be used to kindle or accelerate the fire.
7. The Alabama Department of Environmental Management requires the burn site to be at least 500 feet from the nearest occupied dwelling and 50 feet from a dwelling on the property on which the burning is being conducted. Burning must take place on the property where the combustible fuel originated; no fuel from other properties shall be permitted to be brought in to be burned.
8. It is the policy of the Guntersville Fire & Rescue to extinguish any fire where complaints are received, **No Exceptions.**

The undersigned applicant understands that failure to comply with any portion of the conditions of this permit shall cause this permit to be of no effect. The issuance of this permit does not indicate that the applicant is in compliance with ADEM's regulations. The applicant understands that they are subject to fines levied by ADEM and/or the City of Guntersville, if they do not comply with above stated regulations.
