MUNICIPAL AIRPORT

The Guntersville Municipal Airport (Joe Starnes Field-8A1) offers a unique and beautiful destination in North Alabama's mountain - lake region. Surrounded by 69,000-acre Lake Guntersville at the southernmost point of the Tennessee River, the airport includes a new 4,000-foot runway plus 20 new T-hangars. Development is underway toward an additional 1,000 feet of runway, with more hangars as well as a new terminal and FBO planned. The ultimate 5,005-foot runway, along with a designated seaplane runway and planned floating docks, will make Guntersville Municipal Airport a special attraction for jet traffic and amphibious flyers alike.
