

**THE MINUTES OF A SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GUNTERSVILLE, ALABAMA
HELD ON OCTOBER 13th 2020**

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Guntersville, Alabama met in a special called meeting to canvas the results of the October 6th run-off election in City Hall in said city on October 13th 2020 at 12:00 NOON. Mayor Leigh Dollar presided as Chairman of the meeting. The following members of the Council were present: Sanchez Watkins, John Myers, Carson Ray, Dink Myers Rudy Cornelius and Randy Whitaker. Phillip Kelley was not present. Betty Jones acted as City Clerk for the meeting. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilman Randy Whitaker. Mayor Dollar welcomed visitors and declared that a quorum was present and opened the meeting for business.

Results of the District 2 Run-off Election

Mayor Dollar turned the meeting over to Clerk Betty Jones to certify the results of the Election held on October 6th, 2020. There were no provisional votes to be counted. There were two cast at the polls, but one had previously voted absentee and one was not registered. The tapes of the count of 140 for Councilman Kelley and 177 for Larry Wilson were certified. Motion to accept the final tabulation by Resolution No. 1163 was made by Councilman Dink Myers and seconded by Councilman Watkins and passed unanimously by a voice vote of all Councilmembers present.

Mayor Dollar presented Larry Wilson with a certificate of election.
