

**THE MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING  
OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GUNTERSVILLE, ALABAMA  
HELD ON FEBRUARY 15<sup>th</sup> 2021**

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Guntersville, Alabama met in a pre-meeting in City Hall in said city on February 15<sup>th</sup> 2021 at 4:30 p.m. to discuss matters to come before the Council. In a regular meeting in Town Hall at 5:00 p.m. Mayor Leigh Dollar presided as Chairman of the meeting. The following members of the Council were present: Sanchez Watkins, Larry Wilson, John Myers, Carson Ray, Dink Myers, Rich Russell and Randy Whitaker. Betty Jones acted as City Clerk for the meeting. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilman Randy Whitaker. Mayor Dollar welcomed visitors and declared that a quorum was present and opened the meeting for business.

**Minutes**

Mayor Dollar announced that copies of the minutes from the February 1<sup>st</sup> 2021 Regular Meeting have been distributed to the members of the Council. There being no corrections or additions the same on motion duly made and second stood approved.

**Personnel Report** – Mayor Dollar called upon Renea Rowan to give the following personnel report:

**Police Department:** Deputy Chief Ryan Darnell selected applicant Jennifer Flint to fill the open position of Communications Officer. Mrs. Flint accepted our offer and began employment as a full-time employee on 2/10/21.

Motion to approve was made by Councilman Dink Myers and seconded by Councilman John Myers and passed unanimously by a voice vote of all Councilmembers present.

**Resolution to Approve Contract with Cobbs Allen**

Mayor Dollar introduced **Resolution No. 1187** to contract with Cobbs Allen for employee insurance and personnel services.

Two companies made presentations to the City and Cobbs Allen was selected by Renea Rowan and Mayor Dollar. Lincoln and VSP will be moved to Cobbs Allen and Allstate will remain with Will Parsons. This service will be at no cost to the City.

Motion to approve was made by Councilman Dink Myers and seconded by Councilman Whitaker and passed unanimously by a voice vote of all Councilmembers present.

**Resolution to approve Lighting Quote thru Sourcewell Purchasing Cooperative**

Mayor Dollar introduced **Resolution No. 1188** to approve pickleball, skate park and basketball court lighting quote thru Sourcewell Purchasing Cooperative to be purchased from Musco Lighting at a cost of \$49,200.00. Councilman Whitaker confirmed with Matt Bryant that the warranty was for 25 years and included changing the light bulbs and Matt concurred.

Motion to approve was made by Councilman Ray and seconded by Councilman Whitaker and passed unanimously by a voice vote of all Councilmembers present.

**Set Public Hearing for Special Election**

Mayor Dollar entertained a motion to set a public hearing to hold a special election for ad valorem tax for school purposes for March 1<sup>st</sup>. Motion to set the public hearing was made by Councilman Russell and seconded by Councilman John Myers and passed unanimously by a voice vote of all Councilmembers present.

**Tree Commission Board Appointment**

Mayor Dollar entertained a motion to appoint Dick Rose to the Tree Commission Board. Motion to approve was made by Councilman Whitaker and seconded by Councilman Wilson and passed unanimously by a voice vote of all Councilmembers present.

**Set a Public Hearing for Jazzy at the Glover**

Mayor Dollar entertained a motion to set a public hearing to consider an On and Off Premise Beer and Wine License for Jazell Sewell DBA Jazzy at the Glover located at 425 Gunter Avenue. Motion to set the hearing for March 1<sup>st</sup> was made by Councilman Ray and seconded by Councilman Whitaker and passed unanimously by a voice vote of all Councilmembers present.
