The Mayor and City Council of the City of Guntersville, Alabama met in a pre-meeting in City Hall in said city on May 15th 2023 at 4:30 p.m. to discuss matters to come before the Council. Afterwards in a regular meeting in Town Hall at 5:00 p.m. Mayor Dollar presided as Chairman. Betty Jones acted as City Clerk for the meeting. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilman Randy Whitaker. Mayor Dollar welcomed visitors and declared that a quorum was present and opened the meeting for business.

Minutes

Mayor Dollar announced that copies of the minutes from the May 8th Regular Meeting have been distributed to the members of the Council. There being no corrections or additions the same on motion duly made and second stood approved.

Personnel Report – Mayor Dollar reported there was no Personnel Report.

Resolution to Approve Bid for Recycling Trailers

Mayor Dollar introduced **Resolution No. 1318** to approve bid for Recycling Trailers for the Sanitation/Recycling Department. Bids were received from Shelton Steel for eight (8) 6ft x 12ft trailers at \$4,800.00 each for a total of \$38,400.00 and four (4) 6ft x 16ft at \$6,550.00 each for a total of \$26,200.00. The City received funding thru an ADEM Grant that covers \$29,280.00 of the cost with the City cost to be \$9,120.00. Department Head Jamie Bishop reported to the Council that these were additions to the fleet due to new business. Council members questioned keeping inventories and using anti-theft chips and Mr. Bishop stated he was trying to get the inventory updated at the moment. Motion to approve was made by Councilman Whitaker and seconded by Councilman Ray and passed unanimously by a voice vote of all Councilmember present.

Special Event Permit for B&B Bartending LLC

Mayor Dollar entertained a motion to approve a Special Event Permit for B&B Bartending LLC for the sale of Special Event Liquor for HydroFest June 24th thru 25th 2023. The location would be from 1500 Sunset Drive from the Guntersville Recreation Center to the Water Treatment Plant. Motion to approve was made by Councilman Russell and seconded by Councilman Dink Myers and passed by the following roll call vote:
